## **Learning Bibliolog** in an Intercultural Context

The Bibliolog takes people quickly and at the same time deeply into a biblical text from the perspective of biblical figures. The intercultural Bibliolog training offers interested people from different countries and cultural backgrounds the opportunity to learn the basic steps of Bibliolog in English. Through intercultural exchange, participants learn how to practise Bibliolog in their contexts so that people can discover biblical texts interactively and in a personally meaningful way their context. The participants are treated individually, they are perceived as experts on the text and their ability to participate and democratize is strengthened. At the same time, the Bibliolog offers a safe framework for their own voice, so that people who are not used to such approaches can also participate.

The Bibliolog has now spread not only in Germany and Europe, but has also been very well received in some Latin American, Asian and African countries: It is open to different approaches to the Bible and does not any educational prerequisites. hierarchically oriented churches, it strengthens personal access to the Bible and dialog. Participants can find themselves with their own spirituality and personal issues. At the same time, it is culturally open, as the participants interpret the text with their own experiences. The prerequisite for this, however, is that the Bibliolog is expertly guided. This course enables you to do this.
